Valleyfest is a non-profit organization 501C (3).
The purpose of the Valleyfest Foundation is to assist children that meet the qualifications who live in the Spokane Valley with small financial grants. Our Board of Directors of the Valleyfest Foundation adopted the following guidelines for the Valleyfest event.

Political Booths/Candidates/Issues have very specific guidelines.
These guidelines are the following:

1. Valleyfest will provide 1 8-foot table. Any additional supplies (tables, awnings, chairs, etc.) will be the responsibility of the group assigned to the booth.
2. Amplification equipment will not be allowed in the park.
3. Candidates and volunteers with the candidates will be required to stay within their assigned booth space. Strictly enforced.
4. Political signs, banners, and brochures must be confined to the booth area.
5. Provide a free activity for children.
6. Fees for the booth are the following:
The booth will be \$100.00 per candidate within the booth area.
The booth rate for current issues will be defined as \$100.00 per issue.
